Limited-Access Programs

- **Bachelor Degree Program:** RN to BSN
- **Associate Degree Programs:** Nursing , Dental Assisting Technology and Management, Emergency Medical Services, Physical Therapist Assistant, Licensed Practical Nurse to Associate Degree Nurse Bridge, Radiologic Technology
- **College Credit Certificate Programs:** Emergency Medical Technician, Paramedic
- **Applied Technology Diploma:** Dental Assisting
- **Postsecondary Adult Vocational Certificate Program:** Surgical Technology

A limited-access program is one in which both program admission and course registration is restricted to a certain number of students meeting predetermined criteria. Limited-access status is justified when student demand exceeds available resources or accreditation requirements (e.g., student/faculty ratios, instructional facilities and equipment, clinical sites) or the nature of the program calls for specific admission requirements. Limited-access programs have admissions processes and criteria beyond general college admissions. While any student meeting the minimum criteria is encouraged to apply, not all applicants may be accepted for the desired term.

Notice: Clinical agencies that are used for CF Health Sciences programs learning experiences require national criminal background checks and substance screening on their employees.

Therefore, the CF Health Sciences Division must conduct national criminal background checks and substance screenings on entering students who will use these facilities during the course of their program. These national background checks and substance screenings will be completed at the student's expense.
