**Career and Technical Certificate -** Career and Technical Certificate programs offer you an alternative academic credential to the longer undergraduate or graduate degree programs. A technical certificate is a program of study based in clock hours of college-level technical courses that prepares students with the opportunity for immediate employment in a specific occupational field. It generally does not require the completion of general education courses.

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
