Additional items to be submitted with your CJI application include:

- Copy of your Law Enforcement CJBAT results (must be within last 4 years)
- Copy of your Corrections Certificate
- If you are currently employed as a Correctional Officer, you must submit a letter from your agency stating that you have had a background check per FS 943.13 and the results.
- If you are not currently employed as a Correctional Officer, a background check must be completed by the Criminal Justice Institute, the cost is \$55.

**<u>MANDATORY</u> Academy Orientation which will be held at the Criminal Justice Institute located at 3001 S.W. College Road, Building 31, Room 106, will be announced at a later date. Attire for orientation will be agency uniform or business dress only, no T-shirts, tank tops, jeans, or shorts.
