If your College has a program considered new and innovative <u>or</u> a program that demonstrates exceptional student services, we encourage you to complete this application. The program **must** have been in existence for at least 12 months prior to your submission, and each College is allowed one nomination.

A group of judges will meet to review the submissions, and up to three finalists will be selected and notified by April 15. All finalists will present their programs during the SDC Spring Conference on May 19, and the 2022 Winner will be announced before the end of the event. A \$700 award will be mailed to the Winner's College Foundation, and they will present their program during the AFC Annual Meeting and Conference on November 14-18 as well.
