

- 3. Submit your Florida Residency Declaration.
- 4. Complete a placement test (if needed). If you have taken the SAT, ACT or PERT within the last two years, you may submit those results. Submit official ACT (#0721) and SAT (#5127) results for every test taken.
- 5. Submit official transcripts from your high school and any colleges and universities you have attended.
