1. Apply online at **CF.edu/Apply**. The earlier you apply, the better your chances to get your ideal course schedule and financial aid opportunities. CF has ongoing admissions.
2. Submit your FAFSA at **www.StudentAid.gov**.
3. Submit your Florida Residency Declaration.
4. Complete a placement test (if needed). If you have taken the SAT, ACT or PERT within the last two years, you may submit those results. Submit official ACT (#0721) and SAT (#5127) results for every test taken.
5. Submit official transcripts from your high school and any colleges and universities you have attended.
