

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English for Academic Purposes

CF accepts IETLS (5.5), TOEFL (61) or STEP EIKEN (2A+) test scores.

We accept students at all English fluency levels and have courses to assist you.

CF offers language courses as an integral part of your academic degree program. Improve your English language skills in order to be successful in college-level courses. CF's EAP program offers two levels of instruction in three skill areas: reading, writing and grammar, and speech and listening.

CF accepts IETLS (5.5), TOEFL (61) or STEP EIKEN (2A+) test scores. With these scores, you will not be required to take the English portion of the placement test, but you will take the math sections.

Students without English proficiency test scores will take a placement exam upon arrival at CF in order to determine English and math skill levels. Based on the results of the placement test, students who are not ready for college-level courses will be placed in English for Academic Purposes (EAP)* or other preparatory courses.

CF advisors will work with you to ensure that you are taking the courses appropriate for your level and receive the education you need in order to be successful.

* ESL/EAP are only offered at the CF Ocala Campus.

Apply online at www.CF.edu/Apply. There is a \$30 application fee. After you complete the application, you will receive an email with your student ID number.

Evidence of financial responsibility is required to pay for tuition and fees, textbook costs, medical/health insurance and living expenses.

Send a copy of your passport to international@cf.edu. Include your CF student ID number in your email.

Send a copy of your IETLS (5.5), TOEFL (61) or STEP EIKEN (2A+) scores to international@cf.edu. This step is optional.

After you complete these steps

- ✓ CF will send your acceptance letter and Form I-20 (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status for Academic and Language Students).
- ✓ You will receive instructions on how to pay I-901 SEVIS fee, complete Form DS-160 Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application and schedule visa interview.
- ✓ If you are a transfer F-1 student or applying for change of status, please contact International Student Services for further instructions.

Application deadlines

CF accepts international student applications year-round but the following deadlines must be met to ensure that applications are processed and admission packets are received on time. Deadlines are also set to allow time for visa interview and process.

- July 1 fall semester (begins mid-August)
- Dec. 1 spring semester (begins early January)
- April 1 summer semester (begins early May)
