Get Financial Assistance

- Upon admission, submit a CF scholarship application, available in the MyCF portal at » mycf.cf.edu.
- Apply for an FSA ID at » studentaid.gov
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid at » www.FAFSA.gov (school code: 001471).

Submit Admission Requirements

- Go to » www.CF.edu and click on MyCF. Enter your CF ID number and password (created when you completed application).
- Check remaining admission requirements listed under the Admissions Status tab; view requirements and submit accordingly.
- Under the Admissions Status tab, choose the option "pay later" and then submit your DCF Waiver or Homeless status documents to have application fee waived.
- Complete Residency Declaration Form and upload supporting documents; found under the Admissions Status tab. Select Ward of or Adopted by the State or Homeless for Residency type, then submit required supporting documents as proof.
- Submit an official high school or GED transcript, as well as any other college you have attended

Submit Your Placement Test Scores

- Request your SAT scores from » www.Collegeboard.com, or request ACT scores from » www.ACT.org, or submit PERT scores or take the PERT at the CF Ocala, Citrus or Levy Campus.
- Additionally, submit any passing exam scores for AP, IB or AICE.

Register your Patriots Mail

- Login at MyCF, then click on the Patriots Mail tab.

Complete Orientation
