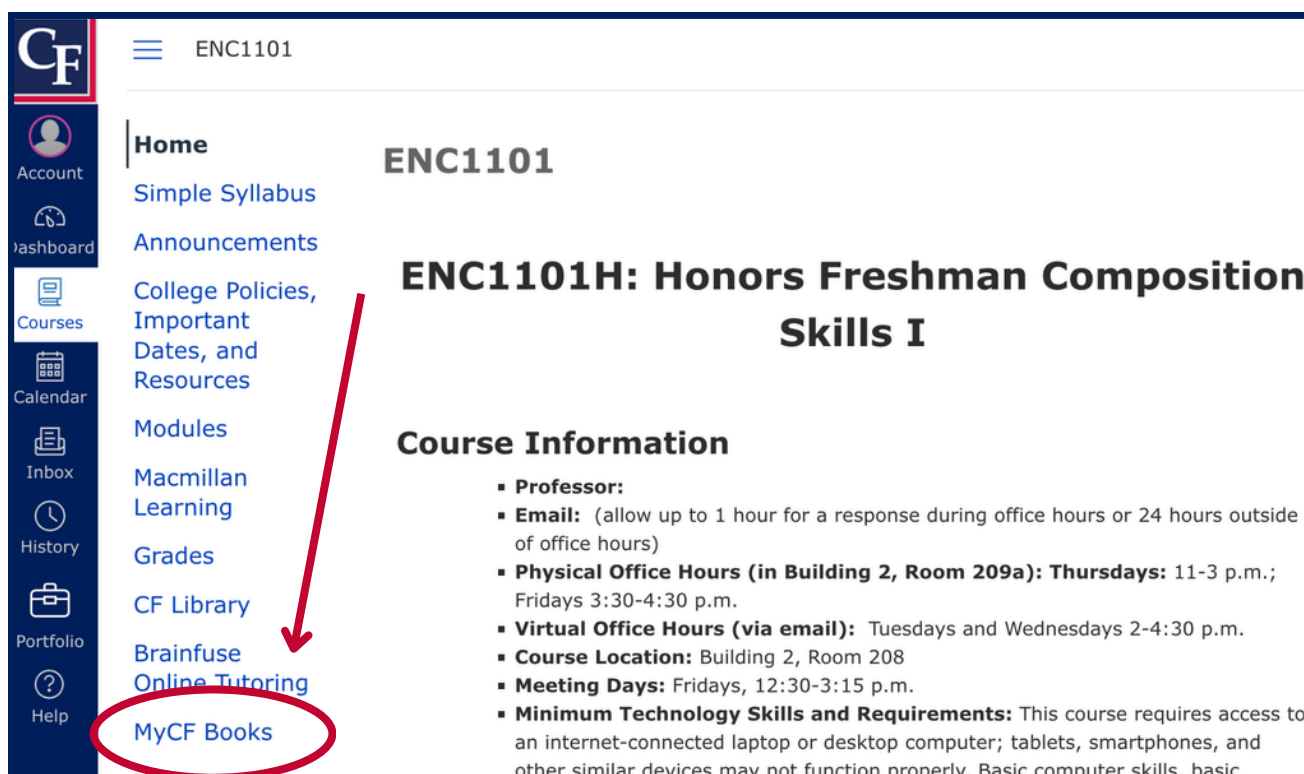


# MyCF Books
