HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1: ACADEMY REQUIREMENTS

Review academy admission criteria to ensure that you meet the requirements of the program. Detailed admission criteria may be found in the ACADEMY RECRUIT APPLICATION PACKET.

STEP 2: COLLEGE APPLICATION

Complete the College of Central Florida application process. Register on- line by going to www.cf.edu . For additional information regarding the admission process follow the link for ADMISSIONS. When ready, click on “Apply Now” and follow instructions to complete. There is a \$30 application fee.

STEP 3: FDLE BAT Test

Take and pass the BAT test. (Law Enforcement- LE BAT or Corrections- COBAT). There is a minimum passing score to qualify for admittance to the program. Follow instructions below to create an account with Pearson Vue and register for the test.

- In the URL bar type www.pearsonvue.com and hit enter
- Click for test takers
- Click schedule for exam
- Click on “A to Z of all programs”
- Click on “F” for Florida Department of Law Enforcement
- Click on Florida Department of Law Enforcement
- This will bring you to the FDLE page. Click on Basic Abilities Test (BAT)
- This will bring you to the Basic Abilities Test page. Click on create account
- Review Pearson Vue Privacy Policy Acceptance. Click I agree
- Click “I do not know my BAT ID”
- Enter your personal information to create an account
- Enter your email and then click next. Continue to follow the on screen instructions to pay for and schedule your exam.

STEP 4: PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

You must pass a physical examination by a licensed PHYSICIAN, CERTIFIED ADVANCED REGISTERED NURSE PRACTITIONER OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT within six months prior to the start of class. The FDLE CJSTC 75 FORM as well as instructions for completion can be found in the ACADEMY RECRUIT APPLICATION PACKET .

STEP 5: PHYSICAL ABILITIES COURSE PACKET-LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY ONLY

Take and pass the Physical Abilities Course (PAC). The PAC is composed of various exercise elements and is designed to measure balance, muscular endurance, strength, flexibility, anaerobic capacity plus fine motor skills. STEP 6: FINANCIAL AID

To be considered for financial aid, you must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Computers are available for use in the Learning Support Center (Building 3, Room 101) or in the Enrollment Service Center (Bryant Student Union, Building 5, Room 102). STEP 8: RECRUIT APPLICATION PACKET

Complete the CF CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE ACADEMY RECRUIT APPLICATION PACKET in its entirety.

STEP 9: PACKET REVIEW

When you have completed the Application Packet, the BAT test, the Physical Exam, the PAC (if applicable) and have received your CF student ID number, you must call to schedule a packet review. Appointments can be scheduled by calling Criminal Justice 352-854-2322 ext. 1569 or email baldwinc@cf.edu

Applications and all required documents must be submitted as a package. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

STEP 10: CRIMINAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

Admission into the Law Enforcement or Correction Programs requires a national criminal background investigation (fingerprinting) on all applicants. You will be directed to complete the background investigation after the packet review. Pay for your background check on line.
