Courses in the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Training program are designed to enhance an officer's knowledge, skills and abilities in a specific area.

To register for this course, agency training officers should notify the CJI prior to the beginning of the program with the names of current officers who are authorized to attend. **If an officer who is registered cannot attend, please notify CJI prior to the start of the course.**
