This course will provide an overview of changes made to the Florida Basic Recruit Training Program: High Liability Defensive Tactics and the new Advanced Defensive Tactics course. **The course is necessary to update an existing Defensive Tactics Instructor certification and will be mandatory as of October 1, 2020.** The current criminal justice instructor acquire the basic skills and knowledge necessary to effectively provide defensive tactics training to criminal justice personnel. The course will be taught by instructors with extensive backgrounds in defensive tactics and use of force. To register for this course, agency training officers should notify the CJI prior to the beginning of the program with the names of officers authorized to attend. If an officer who is registered cannot attend, please notify CJI prior to the start of the course.

Casual clothing is recommended. Shorts, tank tops, and/or offensive T-shirts are **not** acceptable attire. Please use the south parking lot and park in spaces with white markings.
