This 24-hour course will teach participating officers how to skillfully recognize and properly evaluate impaired driving suspects, from the initial observation of the vehicle to the arrest and processing of the suspect. BUI detection will also be covered for marine assigned units.

Beginning with the detection of the impaired driver and the standardized sobriety testing procedures commissioned by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), the course will also cover enforcement strategies and issues surrounding Miranda and Implied Consent. Additionally, officers will learn how to properly document their observations for courtroom presentation.

This course is part of the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Advanced Training program. These specialized courses are designed to enhance an officer's knowledge, skills and abilities for job performance.

To register for this course, agency training officers should notify the CJI prior to the beginning of the program with the names of officers authorized to attend. If an officer who is registered cannot attend, please notify CJI prior to the start of the course. Please use the south parking lot and park in spaces with white markings.
