LEAD INSTRUCTOR: Dr. R. "Doc" Davis a former Navy Corpsman who served with the 2nd Battalion, 5th Marines. He is also a 20 year veteran of law enforcement, having retired from the Boynton Beach Police Department in Florida, where he built and commanded the agency's hostage negotiation and critical incident stress management programs. Dr. Davis' degree is in psychology and his research interests focus on the areas of crisis intervention, hostage negotiation, human stress responses and Autism.

This 40-hour course will provide instruction on the topic of Hostage Negotiation with the skills needed to resolve a situation involving a hostage taker, barricaded subject or suicidal individual.

This course is part of the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission Specialized Training program. The course is designed to enhance an officer's knowledge, skills and abilities for job performance, and provide incentive pay for completion.

To register for this course, agency training officers should notify the CJI prior to the beginning of the program with the names of officers authorized to attend. If an officer who is registered cannot attend, please notify CJI prior to the start of the course.

Casual clothing is recommended. Shorts, tank tops, and/or offensive T-shirts are **not** acceptable attire. Please use the south parking lot and park in spaces with white markings.
