This course is part of the Criminal Justice Specialized Instructor Course program. This course is designed to enhance an officer's knowledge, skills and abilities for job performance.

The primary purpose of this course is to provide the Firearms Instructor Update to full-time (active) instructors at Law Enforcement Academies so sufficient academy personnel are certified for basic law enforcement recruit classes beginning July 1, 2023. (Note: Additional training sessions will be scheduled to update law enforcement agency personnel prior to the re-certification deadline of June 30, 2024).

Upon completion of this course, instructor students will be eligible for re-certification by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) as a High-Liability instructor to teach Firearms. Students must pass with a score of 85% or better on the written exam. ***Pre-Requisites: Current CJSTC General Instructor Certification AND Current High Liability Firearms Instructor Certification.***
