Instructional Goal:

To prepare an instructor student to obtain Commission certification as a high-liability instructor in rifles and instruct the Patrol Rifle Operator Course and the Patrol Rifle Instructor Course.

Equipment and Ammunition Requirements:

- Duty rifle with approximately 750 rounds of rifle ammunition
- Optic preferred; iron sights must be accessible
- Weapon-mounted flashlight preferred (not required); Minimum of a handheld flashlight
- Sling required
- Six (6) dummy rounds, if available
- Duty handgun with 250 rounds of handgun ammunition (for transition drills)
- Three (3) magazines for your long gun

Additional Notes:

- This is a 32-hour course
- Students should be prepared to **qualify on Day 1**.
- There will be a **written end-of-course examination**, as this is an FDLE Instructor Course. Passing score is 85%.
- We are keeping the class small, no more than 12 attendees. Preference will be given to Region VI agency training authorizations.
- Certification Prerequisite: **A student must possess a Handgun Instructor Certification before attending this course.**

To register for this course, agency training officers should notify the CJI prior to the beginning of the program with the names of the officers who will be authorized to attend.
