While so much changed around us last year causing unprecedented challenges from tragic losses to incredible opportunities, the CF Foundation found itself at the end of 2020 with reason to celebrate successes and embrace steps to lead us to future success.

The foundation's comprehensive campaign — Reaching Higher: The Campaign for the College of Central Florida — ended with more than \$25 million, surpassing the goal of \$20 million. This was the largest campaign in our history and we could not have achieved such heights without the support of individuals, organizations, and general goodwill of the communities we serve. The campaign was certainly one of the largest in the nation for an individual community college. Many milestones were achieved, with the most significant being the largest gift by an individual to the foundation — more than \$6 million.

I continue to be in awe of the communities we serve and their commitment to helping transform the lives of students through career training and higher education. I am also in awe of the college and foundation staff for their commitment to student success. Both had a hard reset to address the changed, and ever-changing, environment to our business. The college and foundation never closed. We increased or created new ways to do our jobs so our service had a positive impact on our students — especially in those early days of the pandemic.

Through it all, we created 10 new scholarships, an endowed chair, and contributed more than \$3.8 million to the college through scholarship, academic/institutional and cultural/community support.

I invite you to review our unaudited financials on the following page. We experienced great success, and it is because of our donors' trust and investment in the story that is CF and what the foundation provides to our community.

There are many challenges and opportunities ahead. The foundation staff continues to plan and prepare for what comes next. With your support, we will always be here to help the students at CF.






2020 Sources of Revenue
