## STEPS TO CF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CONDITIONS

(Scholarships Taking Elementary Promising Students to the College of Central Florida)

- 1. Student must earn a high school diploma or achieve a General Education Development Certificate.
- 2. Student must have completed all College of Central Florida (CF) admissions and financial aid applications and be eligible to enroll at CF.
- 3. Must be a College of Central Florida certificate- or degree-seeking student.
- 4. Student must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in middle school, high school and at CF.
- 5. Student must use the \$4,000 scholarship within eleven (11) years from the date of the initial 5th grade STEPS to CF award; scholarship is not transferable to another institution. Scholarship funds are awarded as follows:

\$1,000 for full-time fall/spring classes (12<sup>+</sup> credit hours) \$500 for part-time fall/spring classes (6-9 credit hours) Up to \$500 for summer semester classes

6. Student must remain drug- and crime-free throughout middle school, high school and at CF.

The STEPS to CF Scholarship can be used to pay for tuition, textbooks and fees for any program of study at CF.
