



# Citrus County Hospital Board Nursing Endowed Chair

## About the Scholarship

- The CCHB Nursing Endowed Chair scholarship, funded by the CF Foundation, Citrus County Hospital Board and Florida legislature, is an \$11.7 million endowment supporting nursing education in Citrus County. The endowment funds scholarships for Citrus County residents who have been officially admitted into the Associate Degree Nursing program.
- All in-state tuition and lab fees for the ADN program will be covered by the scholarship.
- The scholarship does not cover textbooks and other program-related expenses such as uniforms and equipment.
- Scholarship recipients may take classes at either the Wilton Simpson Citrus Campus or Ocala Campus.

## Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the scholarship, students must:

- Be current Citrus County residents with a physical address in Citrus County (P.O. box addresses are not eligible).
- Be accepted in the limited access ADN program. This is a secondary application beyond the general admissions application and assesses the student's readiness to enter the program.
- Have submitted a CF scholarship application each academic year.
- Have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid each academic year.

## How to Get Started

- Apply to CF at » [www.CF.edu/Apply](http://www.CF.edu/Apply). Pay the one-time \$30 application fee and submit any needed documents, such as the Residency Declaration Form and official high school or GED transcript, through the » [mycf.cf.edu](http://mycf.cf.edu) student portal.
- Upon admission, submit a CF scholarship application, available in the MyCF portal at » [mycf.cf.edu](http://mycf.cf.edu).
- Apply for an FSA ID at » [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov) and complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid at » [www.FAFSA.gov](http://www.FAFSA.gov) (school code: 001471).
- Upon acceptance to CF, apply to the limited access ADN program. The application window for the fall 2024 semester is April 1 through May 9. Submit your application at » [www.CF.edu/ADNapplication](http://www.CF.edu/ADNapplication).
