## Dental Hygiene - Associate in Science

Dental hygienists are preventive oral health professionals licensed to provide educational, clinical, research, administrative and therapeutic services supporting total health through the promotion of optimum oral health.

Upon completion of this program, students are eligible to sit for the National Dental Hygiene Board examination and the state clinical examination to receive licensure.

To become a dental hygienist in Florida, you must meet the requirements of the Florida Board of Dentistry and this program will prepare students to meet those requirements.
