Eligibility and Requirements

- Must be able to prepare a 3-5 minute presentation on "The Most Important Things for New Students to Learn at CF Orientation"
- Must attend an interview with the Orientation committee

Selection Process

All applicants must have their application packets turned in to Enrollment Services. Applicants who meet the minimum criteria will be contacted for a scheduled interview.
