I. Purpose

To establish guidelines for readmission of service members following service-related absences.

II. Guidelines

In accordance with Federal Student Aid requirements, service members and reservists who are temporarily unable to attend class or have to suspend their studies due to service requirements must be promptly readmitted to a program with the same academic status they had when last attending college.
