In addition to many of the same amenities you will find at the Ocala Campus, the Levy Campus offers fully equipped multi-purpose classrooms, state-of-the-art computer labs for college credit and corporate education courses, a large multi-discipline science lab, and 3,000 square feet of exhibit and conference space that will accommodate nearly 200 guests.

Academic Programs

The Levy Campus offers a number of degree and certificate programs, including the Associate in Arts degree, which is typically the track students pursue to transfer to a four-year bachelor's degree program. The Levy Campus offers programs in Welding Technology and Emergency Medical Services, as well as prerequisite courses leading to Associate in Science degrees in a variety of fields including nursing. Several certificates and degrees are available entirely online.

Student Services

The Levy Campus offers a variety of academic and support services for students. Admission, assessment, placement and registration services are available, and academic advisors are on hand to guide you through your educational choices in credit and noncredit programs.

The Testing Center provides services required for admission and placement into academic and vocational programs, as well as for special fields of training.

The Learning Resources Center offers hundreds of e-videos, e-books and publication databases for research. Study with a group in private study rooms with white boards or alone in individual study pods with foot rests and electrical outlets.

The Learning Support Center offers tutoring in many subjects. Group and private tutoring appointments are available.


Adult General Education Programs
