Schools

Schools are wonderful places to make a difference in your community. Whether you're assisting in the classroom, tutoring students or helping with events, your time and support can have a lasting impact on students and staff alike.

To get started, visit the website of the school you're interested in volunteering with and search for "volunteer" opportunities. If it's a public school, you'll likely need to complete a general volunteer application. The process is straightforward, but it's important to start early, as it may take a little time to get approved and placed.

If you don't receive a response to an email request, don't give up! Schools are busy places, and a follow-up can make all the difference. Call the school directly and ask for information about volunteering.
